## **2018 CAAIF Research Grant Competition – Allied Health**

The Canadian Asthma, Allergy and Immunology Foundation is a charitable organization, established to improve the educational and research resources of the Canadian Allergy and Immunology community. The Foundation has a \$10,000 budget for start-up grants for CSACI Allied Health Members. For this competition, we will provide two (2) grants for \$5,000 each. Projects must be of relevance to the practice of allergy and immunology in Canada. The CAAIF research committee, chaired by Dr. Harissios Vliagoftis, will be overseeing the application review procedure.

The goals of the Foundation are to raise awareness in allergic diseases. It is not the goal of the Foundation to replace larger granting bodies. Because of the limited nature of our funds, the competition may be appropriate to obtain supplemental funding for larger projects or to initiate a project on an innovative idea that needs preliminary work before a larger grant application can be made. Projects that are more appropriately aimed at the pharmaceutical industry (pilot projects using new or existing therapeutic agents) will not be considered.

The application should include a lay summary of the proposed work; **a two-page outline of the project and its relevance**, a budget with justification and the CV of the applicant. Please keep in mind the modest size of the grant and define the budget appropriately; if there are additional sources of funds that will also support this application, please identify these. More information in this can be found on the application form.
